



## **RAIN FOREST GRAPHING ACTIVITY**

### **SENSE OF TASTE**

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1) The students will taste various fruits grown in the rain forest to appreciate the wide variety of different food products derived from the rain forest.
- 2) The students will graph the class' taste preferences.

#### **MATERIALS:**

large paper plates

4 different rain forest foods

EXAMPLES: pineapple, coconut, mango, banana, papaya  
graph

#### **PROCEDURES:**

- 1) The teacher will place four different rain forest foods on each students plate.
- 2) As each food is tasted by the students the teacher will provide background information about how the food is grown and how it is used or eaten in various parts of the world.
- 3) After every student has tasted each item students will indicate their preference by placing an X on a large class graph.
- 4) The students can be asked to read the graph results to determine what food was most liked or least liked.
